

Grammar: Hellenisms

Latin sometimes uses Greek words and names.

Names will take the Greek form.

The example in the exercises is *Acmen* in Exercise 8 (Catullus). This is in the accusative. Her name would decline as follows:

Case	Name
Nom.	Acme
Acc.	Acmen
Gen.	Acmes
Dat.	Acme

Greek has no ablative.

Other words include those with a 'z' such as *zona*, girdle.
